## Our Green Plan and the Greening SPD

In 2019, the Council declared Vision Carbon Zero, its Climate Emergency pledge.

Now Kensington and Chelsea's "Green Plan" sets out how this will be delivered.

Following consultation with residents, The Green Plan will focus on six environmental priorities:

- improving air quality
- getting to Carbon Zero and tackling climate change
- tackle fuel poverty
- waste minimisation
- enhancing biodiversity
- delivering a green recovery

Also, a "Green Fund" of £10 million over 10 years, will invest in ambitious environmental projects to help deliver the five environmental priorities and deliver a Green Recovery from the COVID-19 Pandemic.

The Green Plan pulls together existing, new and developing environmental related strategies, plans and key targets, into one simple document, so that we can give ourselves the best possible chance of meeting our environmental goals.

## The Greening SPD

The Greening SPD sets out requirements for developers, homeowners and residents when it comes to green issues in planning applications. It will address our "Green Plan" and its priorities from air quality, carbon reduction and biodiversity, laying out the borough's expectations for greener schemes.
