**NOTICE OF MAKING OF ARTICLE 4(1) DIRECTION RELATING TO THE ENTIRE
AREA OF THE ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA**

NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (“the Council”) has made a Direction under Article 4(1) of The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015, as amended (the “GPDO”).

The Direction was made on 20th July 2021 and applies to:-

The entire area of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.

The Direction applies to the development described in the following Class of the GPDO:-

Class MA, Part 3 of Schedule 2 to the GPDO which relates to development consisting of a change of use of a building and any land within its curtilage from a use falling within Class E (commercial, business and service) of Schedule 2 to the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987, as amended (“the UCO”) to a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of Schedule 1 to the UCO.


The effect of the Direction is that the permission granted by Article 3 of the GPDO shall not apply to such development and such development shall not be carried out within the entire area of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea unless planning permission is granted by the Council.

A copy of the Direction and a map defining the area to which it relates may be seen at the offices of the Council at Planning Information Desk, Town Hall, Hornton Street, London, W8 7NX at all reasonable hours or can be viewed on the Council’s website.

Representations may be made concerning the Article 4(1) Direction between 21st July 2021 and 15th September 2021. If you wish to make representations, please send them by email to planningpolicy@rbkc.gov.uk. Any representation must be received by the Council by **5pm on 15th September 2021** and should include your name, postal address and, if desired, an email address.

It is proposed that the Direction shall come into force on 22nd July 2022, subject to the consideration of any representations received during the consultation period and the Direction being confirmed by the Council.
