Statement of the Representations Procedure

This Statement provides the following information in accordance with Regulation 19 of The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended).

(A) THE TITLE OF THE LOCAL PLAN WHICH THE COUNCIL PROPOSES TO SUBMIT

The title of the Local Plan which the Council proposes to submit to the Secretary of State is the **Local Plan Partial Review (LPPR)**.

(B) THE SUBJECT MATTER OF, AND AREA COVERED BY, THE LOCAL PLAN
