**The Local Plan for Kensington and Chelsea – Progress update**

Many of you might be aware that following the tragic fire at Grenfell Tower, the Council has suspended its estate regeneration projects on the Silchester, Warwick Road and Barlby-Treverton estates. In the future, the Council has committed that any changes to these estates would be co-designed with the community and put to a binding vote.

The Council has been undertaking a partial review of its Local Plan which is the main document used by the Council in deciding whether to grant or refuse planning permission for new development. The partial review process started in late 2015 with a number of consultations being undertaken in the process and finally the proposed policies were submitted for examination by an Inspector in May 2017.

Originally we had published planning guidance for the three estates as part of the revisions to the Local Plan. With all future estate regeneration work on these three estates suspended, we formally have to take the original plans out of Local Plan revisions so that any further work can be considered afresh with the residents at a new future date.

As part of the process for progressing with revisions to the plan, an Independent Planning Inspector will hold a hearing in public where the Council and residents can make verbal representations to the Inspector, on the remaining contents of the Local Plan. With the three estates taken out of the Local Plan the Inspector will focus on the remaining contents of the Local Plan which deal with a range of borough-wide planning policies.

**Please note this hearing is not about the general issues and concerns for your local estate. The purpose of this hearing is for the Inspector to consider revisions to the contents of the Local Plan following the conclusion of the previous rounds of consultation.**
