

Public Participation Statement on the Second Draft Planning Contributions Supplementary Planning Document

Regulation 12 of The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended)

The Council has prepared a second draft Planning Contributions Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) following public consultation in September 2017. In accordance with Regulation 12 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, this Statement sets out:

Regulation 12 (a) (i) the persons the local planning authority consulted when preparing the supplementary planning document

The Local Planning Authority has a Local Plan consultation database which has in excess of 2,000 consultees. A mail out was sent to all consultees on the Local Plan database notifying them of the consultation on the Draft Planning Contributions Supplementary Planning Document published in September 2017 and inviting comments. The consultation took place for 6 weeks between 12 September and 24 October 2017. The SPD was also available on-line under 'current consultations' on the planning pages of the Council's website and was open to anyone for comment.

The Local Plan database includes 'general', 'specific', 'prescribed' and 'local' consultation bodies as required by legislation. The 'general consultation' bodies include voluntary bodies such as Kensington Society, Chelsea Society and Tenants and Residents Associations, bodies which represent the interests of different racial, ethnic or national groups such as London Gypsy and Traveller Unit, bodies representing religious groups such as Christ Church Kensington, bodies representing the interests of disabled persons such as Action Disability Kensington and Chelsea and bodies which represent the interests of persons carrying out business in the Royal Borough such as KC Chamber of Commerce.

The 'specific' and 'prescribed' consultation bodies consulted included the Environment Agency; Natural England, Historic England, the Highways Agency, the Clinical Commissioning Group, Thames Water and the Mayor of London (GLA).

The 'local' consultation bodies consulted included individual residents and persons carrying on business in the Royal Borough who signed up to the above database or visited the specific pages of the Council's website.

The Council invited expressions of interest for taking part in a Discussion Group Workshop with other interested stakeholders and Council officers as part of the first consultation. The Council did not receive interest in such workshops.

The Council has tabulated all the responses received by collating them according to the various sections of the SPD and the questions in the accompanying response form. The Council's responses have been made available alongside the Second Draft SPD consultation (see details below).
